EDUCATION & TRAINING

Certificates:

If looking to go to school for a short amount of time, depending on the program, certificate programs can take between 6 months and 2 years to complete depending on the program and institution.

Degree programs:

Associate degree programs can take 2 years to complete while a Bachelor's degree program can take up to 4 years. Master's degrees program can take additional 2 years on top of a Bachelor's degree.
