- **B.** Graduation Celebrations (Informational): Getting several requests for graduation celebration financial support ranging from \$150-\$3,000. To make it fair to all departments, suggests setting a budget aside for all graduation celebrations in an amount not to exceed \$500.00 per celebration. Set aside a budget of approximately \$2,500 to be used in the Spring semester. Only financial means will be provided, but no work/assistance.

This way, we can lend it out and possibly use it if needed.
