Spring 2019 Volleyball Tournament



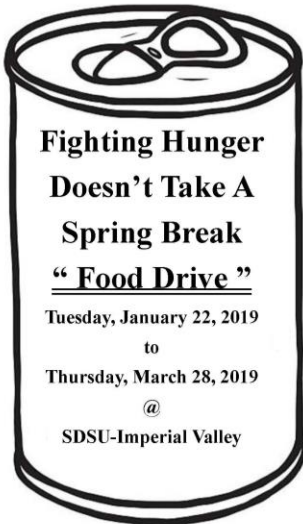
